5% increase in our Parish Levies: the Diocese has decided to increase Parish Levies by 5 percent. The Levy is the monthly contribution made by each Parish to cover the workings of the Diocese; this includes curial salaries, sick and retired priests, seminarians' training, car loans, health insurance, and contributions to the Bishops' Conference of Scotland's various departments. From our own perspective, this means an increase from £1,181 per month to a new total of £1,240.05.. before a penny is spent on the upkeep of the parish!
